The RCG LP meeting in Portugal focused on improving data collection and collaboration for large pelagic species management, including by-catch data standardization and electronic monitoring.

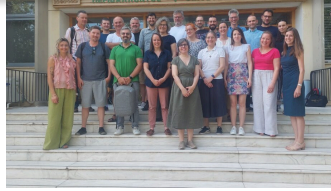
